A Child Who Is Ready For Kindergarten is One Who...

- Uses words to communicate ideas and feelings.
- Follows two and three step directions.
- Prints first name
- Can easily separate from a parent and shows independence.
- Participates in activities and joins others in play.
- Counts from 1-20.
- Identifies numbers 1-10.
- Retells simple stories in sequence.
- Is able to focus on storytelling and book time for at least 5 minutes.
- Demonstrates understanding that letters have names and sounds.
- Identifies most letters.

Mathematics

Your child will learn to...

- Count to 100.
- Write to 20.
- Count by twos, fives, and tens
- Add and subtract within 10
- Analyze and compare shapes,
- Create Patterns.



Language Arts

Your child will learn to...

- Identify upper and lower case letter names and sounds.
- Apply phonemic skills to sound out words.
- Recognize print being from right to left.
- Demonstrate comprehension of important ideas.
- Differentiates between fiction and nonfiction.
- Form upper and lowercase letters correctly.
- Write sentences describing a drawing or photograph.
- Print first and last names.
- Become considerate listeners.
- Articulate ideas clearly in oral speaking.

Your child will learn to...

- Accept people for their unique qualities.
- Show knowledge of grade level prayers.
- Perform community service.
- Portray Christian values and morals through their actions.
- Attend all school mass and on Holy Days of obligation.
