Content Areas taught

Reading Series: Amplify Core Knowledge Language Arts "CKLA"

Take Home Books: Books will be sent home from the classroom to read and be returned when mastered

Reading/Writing Connection: "guess and go" writing

Handwriting: establish good habits now! Use a 3 finger pincer grip.

Math: Houghton Mifflin Harcourt. Building number sense and moving into addition

Religion: We will work on one prayer per month. We will focus on Bible Heroes, Creation, Stations of the Cross and the Rosary etc.

Science: Will be themed monthly. In September we learn about apples.
