
Hello families, I am Mrs. Grolbert!

I truly couldn't ask for a better dream job!


Our Library Collection

- We have about 18,000 books to pick from!
- Our collections include picture books, chapter book fiction, young adult, graphic novels, non-fiction, biographies and reference.
- We keep our collections constantly growing and up to date, to meet our students' interests and needs.
- Digital access to World Book, Discovery Education and our Destiny library catalog are all online for research, in and out of the classroom. All accessible from the Clever.
- Accelerated Reader is our new reading comprehension and book leveling program, that students will be using this year! (Replacing Reading Counts-it is no longer a program)



PS, PK & K

- Visit once a week.
- Check out one book. It stays in the classroom.
- We read together, learn about the sections in a library, how to care for books, and the features of a book.
- Hands on, and social-emotional learning activities pair with our read alouds.



1st & znd Grade

- Visit once a week.
- Check out 2 books each week and they get to bring them home.
- Get in a routine of bringing books every library day!
- Learn to pick just right books using our library genre system to find books independently.
- Hands on learning (STEM) and reflective learning activities accompany our read alouds.

- Use our new reading program, Accelerated Reader (AR), for finding good fit leveled books.
- You can visit <u>www.arbookfind.com</u> to search reading levels for titles you have at home too.
- Collaborative STEAM research projects will be a part of the school year, teamed up with Tech class.
