
SCOPE is our parent/teacher organization. SCOPE stands for St. Charles Organization of Parents & Educators.



We would ask that a portion of your sales that evening be donated to support the SCB Goes Gatsby Auction.



Cost: \$100 (including tax and delivery to SCB) We currently have 34 Infusion Drinkers available.


