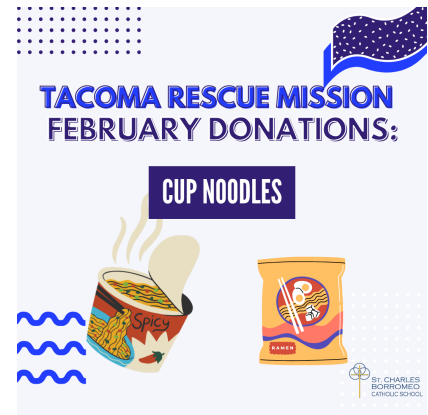


Loving God Through Serving Others

Please drop them off in the large white bins in our main hallway.

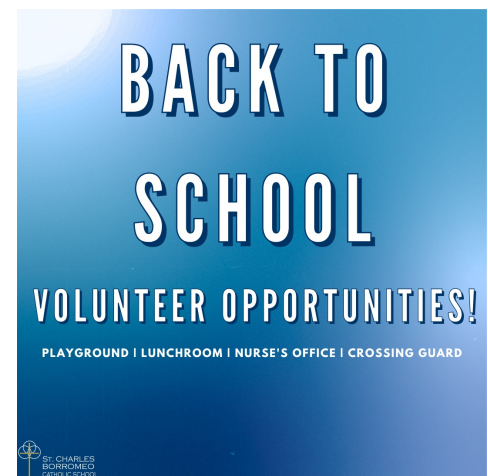
