Thank you for celebrating Catholic Schools Week with us all week. It was a fun week celebrating all that is special about SCB and our community of students, families, teachers, and clergy. The students' service projects were thoughtful and kind gestures to many people in our community - it was



fun to take part in them. The Boosterthon was a fun day of exercise and classroom togetherness, and it was wrapped up with an exciting day of basketball in our gym and bingo.

As we move through our second trimester, we are working on science fair projects, winter MAP testing in a few classes, and moving through our curriculum. I meet with the teachers weekly to review progress in every grade level and students are making good progress in classes with interventions being put in place as needed. Our resource room is working at full capacity, which has been a welcome addition of classroom space to our school. Next year, as we finalize enrollment and see what those needs are, we will be looking to see if we will add more to the learning team in our resource room. We want to make sure we can provide as much academic and study skills support for our students as needed.

In addition to the resource room, our Early Education classrooms are in high demand for next year. We have already been licensed to add a second toddler room in our convent space, which we are excited about. Preschool and PreK are also in very high demand, so we are currently looking to see where we could potentially grow those programs as well. It has been lovely to see how many SCB siblings and the children of SCB Alumni are applying to join us this coming fall.


Off to the Races Applause Auction

For the month of February, we will be collecting Cup Noodles for the Tacoma Rescue Mission.


