I hope that you all enjoyed much needed downtime over the holiday break with family and friends. The halls of SCB were quiet, but it's nice to see everyone back rested and recharged and ready for 2024.

During December, one of the key things we do here at SCB is finish the next year's budget as well as set our **new tuition rates** for the fall. One of the things that we have worked on ENROLLMENT FOR

extensively is having a multi-year plan that sets us up for long term financial viability.

During budgeting we take into consideration our key value of having an *Accessible Catholic Education*, while balancing the reality of what it takes to financially run our school. Compensating our teachers, having high quality programs, and continuing our financial aid and scholarship programs are the guideposts to our planning exercises.

All of this was completed in parallel to managing expenses as closely as possible, understanding increases in current business costs. The true cost of educating each student is significantly higher than our tuition rates charged. Through parish subsidy and fundraising we are able to cover the gap. This is why community support in our annual campaigns and fundraising efforts is crucial; they allow us to offer our programs and keep Catholic education accessible.

Today, we will be sending existing families emails to confirm enrollment for next fall. We are asking for your re-enrollment to be completed by **Tuesday**, **January 16th**.

One change to note for next year for our in-parish families: for 2024-25, we will be changing how we designate in-parish tuition from Kindergarten through 8th grades. We realized that the current process can be confusing and in order to simplify your parish designation, we are changing to having a single form application that is signed off on by the parish financial office for the entire school year. The forms can be found here. Please note that the parish has updated the tithing suggestions as you fill out the in-parish form. For our Catholic families who belong to other parishes, a similar one page form can be found here and will be required as well.

As you discern your next steps, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to me and I am glad to answer them. We'd love to have you all back here at SCB next fall.

My many thanks to our School Commission and our parish leaders for supporting us through the planning process. Their guidance and leadership is allowing SCB to plan for many successful years to come.
