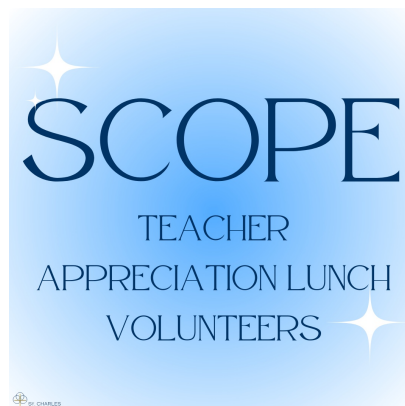

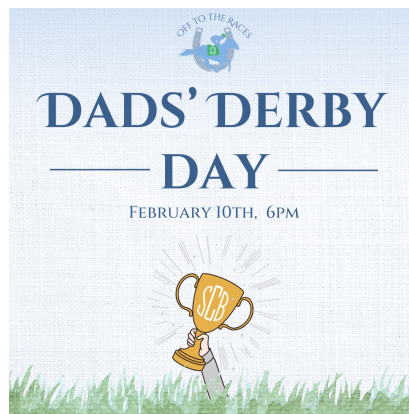
Auction Party: Dads' Derby Day

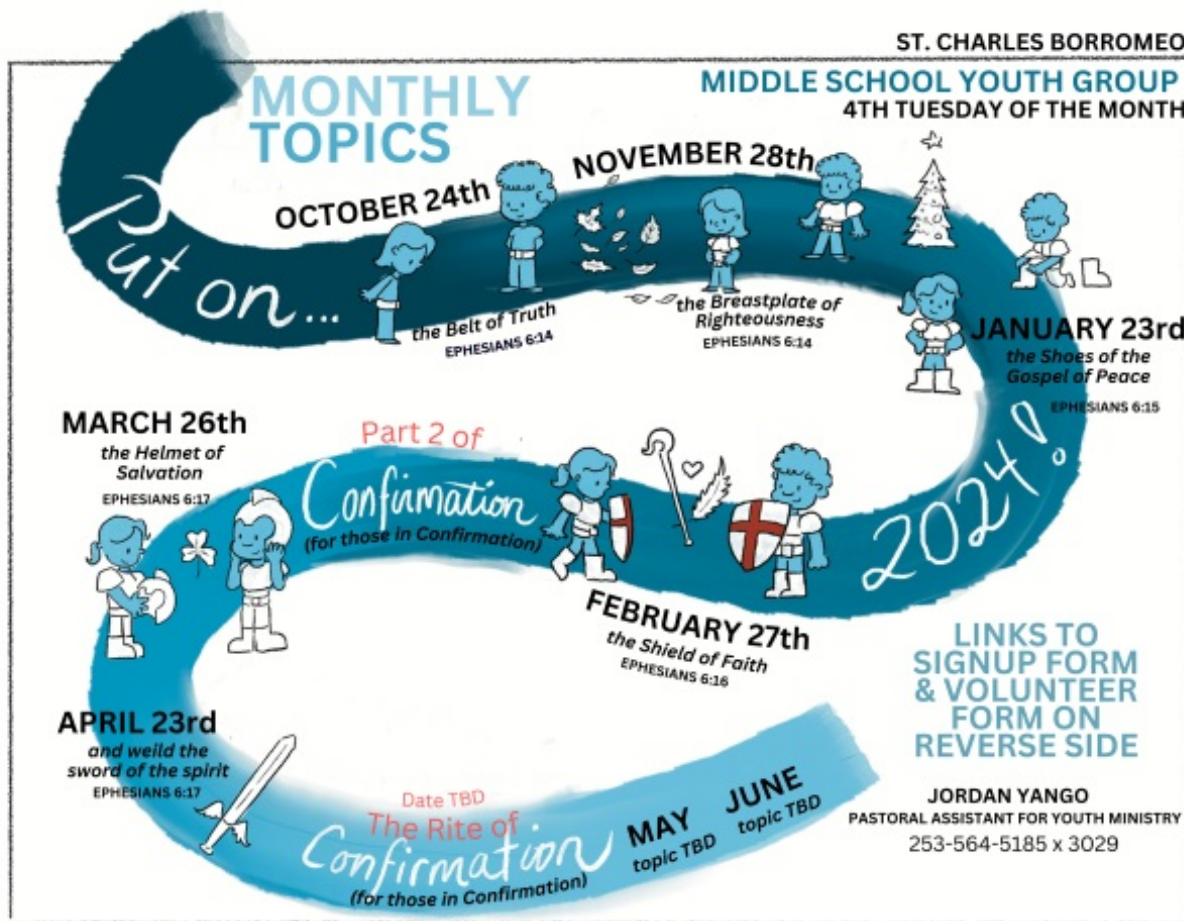
