

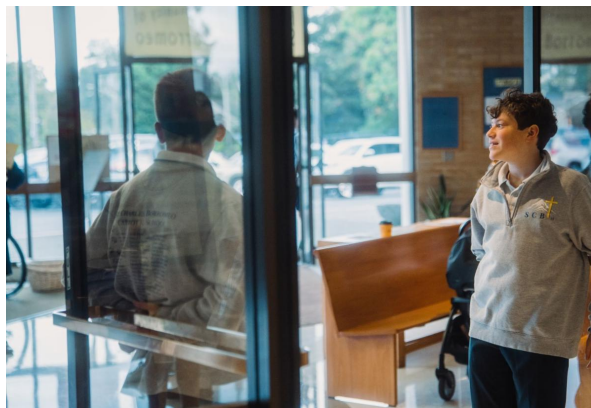

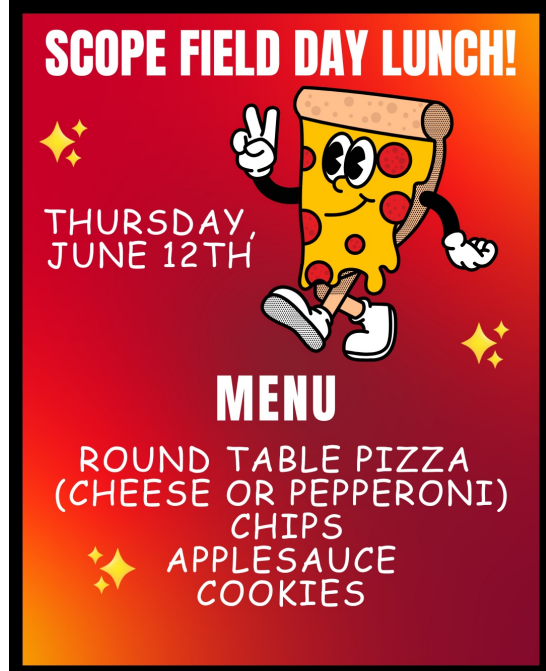
SCOPE
