







What is this?

Beginning later this month, members of our community can purchase shoes before and after school or at weekend Masses. In addition, because of the new drop-off and pick-up procedures, we will also have a google form to purchase shoes as well. Stay tuned for more details on that!



Shoes can then be taken home and stuffed with small useful items, such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, socks, pens, pencils, hairbrushes, soap, etc. or brought as-is to the Liturgy.

All shoes that are brought and presented at The Shoe Liturgy are bought specifically for a child in the Pierce County area. Shoes sizes have been sent to us from our Parish, agencies, and counselors who work with families needing assistance. At the beginning of December, we will collectively present the shoes during a Liturgy at the Church.

We will begin shoe sales during conferences this week! We will also sell before and after masses beginning on November 2nd and before and after school beginning on November 4th.


