# Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures Reminders

## **Drop-Off & Pick-Up Reminders**

Thank you to everyone for your help in the Drop-Off and Pick-Up lines! We continue to make progress each day.

### We have a few reminders:

- Please be sure to pull up all the way so we are able to get as many cars in the lines as possible.
- Please do not drop off your children before 8:05am and leave them unattended. Faculty and Staff will be in their zones promptly at 8:05am.
- If you are entering Zone 1 or Zone 2, you must be through the gates by 8:27am. We close the gates at that time, so we are able to get the remaining students out of their vehicles and into the building for an 8:30am start time.
- School ends at 3pm. The gates into Zones 1 and 2 will not open until 2:55pm. Please do not come early. We need this time to finish the school day and to get the students outside safely without moving vehicles.
- Please be aware of bikers in the Drop-Off & Pick-Up Zones. They will follow the same rules as the cars, but please be cautious.


