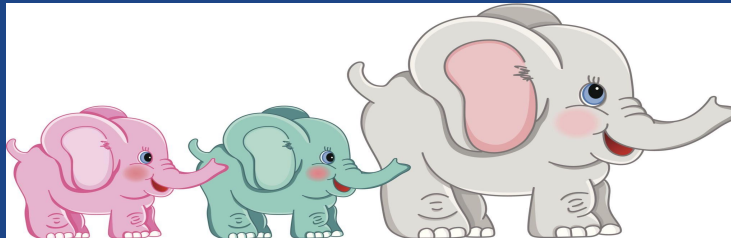


Team Coleman & Welch

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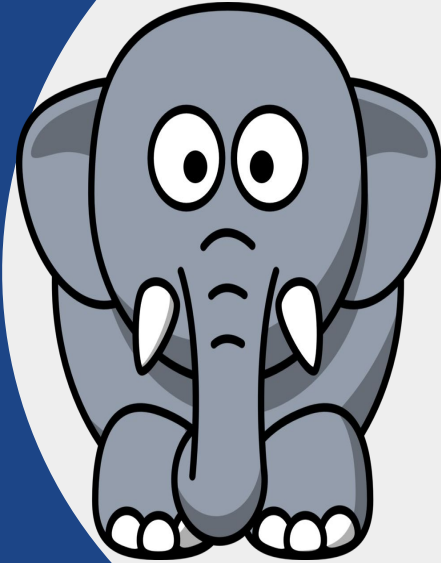

Report cards & assessments

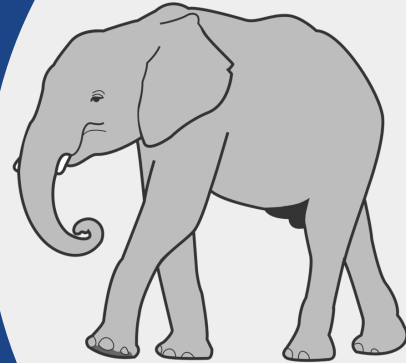

- Music and Movement = pretty much every day. We also see Mr. Lewis and Mr. Malo once a week.

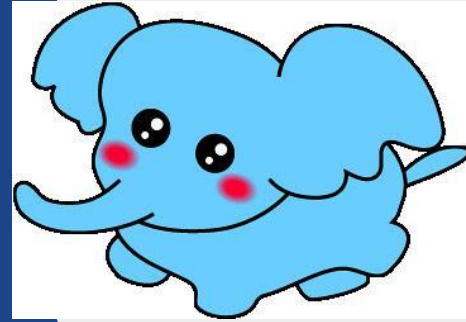
Bathroom and Illness

If your child has a wet accident at school we will help them clean-up and continue their day. We will let you know to refresh their extra clothes bag.

If it is fecal matter and is too significant for them to clean up. We will ask the office to call you to either come and refresh your child or to pick them up to go home.

Because of the young age of our students their immunity is still building, we tend to see varied illness throughout the year. PLEASE let us know if your child has an illness or is on antibiotics. If the disease can spread PLEASE keep them home.

We want them home for an additional 24 hours after their fever has broken, the vomiting has stopped or the thunder down under is resolved. As you might guess it is no fun to be at school sick. If they have a cold PLEASE keep them home if they have a persistent cough or a really runny nose.



Conferences

Conferences will be held on Thursday, October 23rd and Friday, October 24th. I will begin earlier in the week with after school appointments to be able to accommodate 44 families.
