### Big Things Are Happening in the Gym!

Thanks to your generous support during the SCB Goes Gatsby Auction, our gym is getting a transformation — and the project is already underway! These upgrades are designed to enhance both the functionality and comfort of the space for students, staff, and families alike. Here's what's in the works:

- Expanded seating to better accommodate families during events and performances
- New scoring tables and digital scoreboards to support athletic activities and games
- Moveable seating and equipment to allow for more flexible use of the space
- Upgraded basketball hoops and nets, along with new volleyball nets and scoring equipment
- Painting, Signage, and Carpeting of key areas in the gym.

These improvements will help create a more dynamic, engaging, and multifunctional environment for physical education, extracurriculars, and community events. We can't wait for you to see it all come together!

#### MAP Testing This Fall (2nd-8th grades)

We are currently conducting MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) testing, a nationally normed, adaptive assessment that helps us understand where each child is academically in Math and English Language Arts (ELA).

We're happy to share that St. Charles has been very pleased with our students' MAP results to date, and we're committed to building on that success. Our team is using the data to create instructional plans that support continued growth in both subject areas. This assessment is not about high-stakes testing — it's a tool to inform instruction and meet students where they are.

MAP results will be shared with families during parent-teacher conferences in October, where we'll take time to discuss your child's progress and next steps together.

As always, thank you for your ongoing support and for being such a vital part of our school community. We're looking forward to an exciting and enriching fall trimester!


In order to volunteer on campus, you must have completed the Virtus Training. If you have completed the




