
SCB Gives Back

October Service Project

This month we will be making baskets to give to our Veterans in area rest homes. We would love some help gathering items.

We are looking for the following types of items:

- Bags of good ground coffee and teas
- Beef Jerky and Slim Jims.
- Candy (more candy, less chocolate because of melting) – i.e. gummy bears, Swedish fish, bubble gum, hard candies and lollipops.
- Healthy snacks (granola bars, trail mix, protein bars or powders).



- Current issues of magazines (hunting, cars, etc.), sudoku/puzzle books and comic books.
- Nice pens/pencils
- Things to keep cool i.e. insulated water jugs, hand-held electric fans, first aid ice packs, wicking bandanas
- Goodr sunglasses
- Baked goods that are packed so they don't get smashed.
- Lens cleaning cloths and glass cleaner
- Reading material (magazines or books)
- Board games
- Cross-stitch patterns
- Decks of cards

Shoes for the Children

The Shoe Liturgy will take place on Friday, December 5th at 1:45pm.

have a google form to purchase shoes as well. These shoes will be delivered to your student's class each Friday. If you choose to purchase in this way, we will select the shoes for you. There continues to be a GREAT need for shoes in our area. Please prayerfully consider purchasing more than 1 pair of shoes, if possible. Shoes can then be taken home and stuffed with small useful items, such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, socks, pens, pencils, hairbrushes, soap, etc. or brought as-is to the Liturgy.

All shoes that are brought and presented at The Shoe Liturgy are bought specifically for a child in the Pierce County area. Shoes sizes have been sent to us from our Parish, agencies, and counselors who work with families needing assistance. Each box is marked with a specific number. Please do not remove that number. That number ensures the correct pair of shoes goes to the correct organization.

At the beginning of December, we will collectively present the shoes during a Liturgy at the Church.

This is for consideration for both Fulcrum financial aid as well as our St. Charles Endowment aid.






