The front office is busy this time of year with next fall's enrollment, teacher discussions around staffing for next year, and planning the 26-27 school calendar. We have sent a preliminary schedule up to the Archdiocese and as soon as we hear back, we will be sharing our calendar for next year so you can plan accordingly. In addition to the fall, we are also planning for summer sessions which will roll out early February for signups. We look forward to welcoming our summer counselors back and augmenting our team with some great new counselors!



While we plan for the future, we also continue to work on campus improvements. We are pleased to share that we have finalized our recent safety audit, and our school did quite well overall. We were pleased with the readout - the audit highlighted many strengths, along with a few opportunities for further improvement. One area identified was implementing an electronic sign-in process for all visitors, which will further strengthen our ability to monitor who is in the building real-time.

So, in that vein, we will be implementing an electronic sign-in process in our front office over the next month. This system will allow us to know who is in the building in case of emergencies and ensure all families have their own sign-in for ease of entry. Staff will be trained on the system this week, and we anticipate rolling it out in early February. Be on the lookout for directions on how to access the system so you can register your family.

Finally, SCB students are already anticipating another Seahawks win this coming weekend. The enthusiasm was so strong that I got cajoled into another Blue Friday this week as we gear up for the next game - please have your students wear their Blue and Green to cheer on our Seahawks. .



We will be having our Annual Oodles of Noodles competition! Bring your Cup O'Noodles to school to support the Tacoma Rescue Mission!






