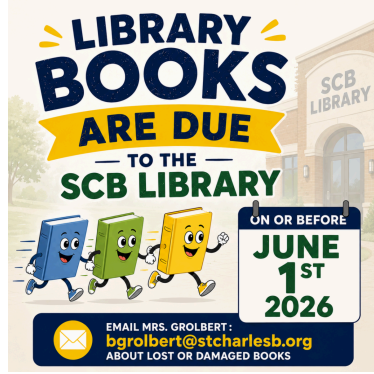

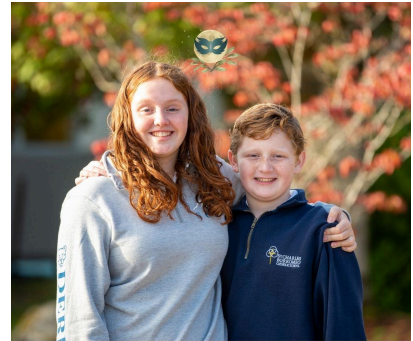

SCOPE

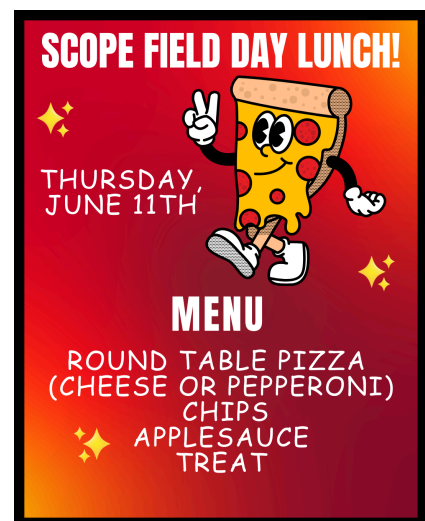
SCOPE is our parent/teacher organization. SCOPE stands for St. Charles Organization of Parents & Educators.
