SPECIALTY CAMP INFORMATION

Drop-off and Pick -Up Information:

West Parking lot will be open all day, with our security guard available for assistance.

All specialty camp attendees will be dropped off and picked up through the Advancement Office doors in the west parking lot.

Check-In Procedure:

Teachers for the specialty camps will manage sign in and sign out for all camps. If your student is going to camp and also attending day camp, they will be escorted back to the convent to check into the day camp by the specialty camp teacher.

Hours of Operation:

Toddlers: 7:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Pre-K - 8th Grade: 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Drop-off and Pick-up:

West Parking lot will be open all day, with security guard available for assistance.

Drop Off Locations:

Toddlers Summer Camp: You will drop off at the normal convent entry on west side of building into the Toddler Room.

PS - 8th grade Day Camp: You will drop off in Mrs. Herrera's Room on the east side of the Convent. K-8 will be in the main building but checked in through the convent.

Both sides of the convent will be marked.

Check-In & Check-Out Procedure Using Brightwheel:

We will be using digital sign-in and sign-out procedure this summer using an app called Brightwheel.

If your student is already in Brightwheel from the school year, we will be placing them in our summer classroom.

If you don't have a Brightwheel account, you will be sent a link to register. When you arrive, you will sign in by scanning a QR code and you will check out the same way.

The Brightwheel app allows our staff to message you throughout the day in case we have any needs for your child and to give you updates.

What to Bring

What to bring each day:

Please be sure to send your child each day with a **labeled:**

- water bottle
- lunch
- extra snack (if needed)
- change of clothes in case they are playing with water
- silent reading book
- sun hat
- sunscreen

The extra change of clothes can stay at Summer Camp if so desired

We will provide a morning and afternoon snack each day!

Sunscreen Information:

We recommend that sunscreen be applied before summer camp each day. We will reapply the sunscreen you send to camp during the day as needed.

Please note the medication form (which is linked below) is needed to do this. We will put each student's sunscreen in a labeled bag for them use throughout their time at camp.

Please Leave the Following at Home:

Electronics! We have plenty of activities for the children to do throughout the day, so we do not allow electronics.

However, if your student needs to bring something to Summer Camp because of an activity they are doing after camp, please check the item in with one of our friendly staff members

Medical Form:

If your child has a severe allergy medication, daily medication, or needs sunscreen reapplied during the day, please complete and return this medication form: [SCB Medical Form](#)
