Youth Confirmation St. Charles & St. Leo Summer Preparation 2026

Youth entering grades 7-12 who have been baptized in the Catholic Church and have received Holy Communion are eligible for the sacrament of Confirmation. We will be offering the option of a summer confirmation program this year. The preparation will consist of 6 sessions including a half-day retreat. Full participation in **all** sessions is required in order to be eligible for summer confirmation.

The summer confirmation sessions will begin with 9:00am Mass at St. Charles. Following Mass we will have a combination of activities, lessons, and service activities. Much of the class session will be outdoors. A schedule of specific events will be shared at the first class session.
